From Teachers' Training to Students' Online Learning

Mathematics Education Program, International College, Suan Sunandha Rajabhat University (SSRUIC) secured the government budget for the fiscal year 2019 starting October 2018 to train teachers of the Office of the Basic Education Commission (OBEC), Ministry of Education. The teachers' training focused on improving grade-9 students' achievement in taking the Ordinary National Education Test (O-NET) for three subjects; Mathematics, Science, and English.
